I am happy to inform the congregation that on June 10 Pine Street Baptist Church entered a lease agreement with Verizon. The lease will allow Verizon to install cellular antennas within our steeple. The lease will go into effect by October 1, 2014. The lease for the space is \$21,600 annually. The total annual rental amount will increase annually on the anniversary of the commencement date to an amount equal to 103% of the annual amount for the prior year.

This annual income is a blessing to our church and its ministries. It is just another example of how God is watching over the church family of 400 South Pine Street. God is our provider and we must place our faith in his goodness and love.

The church would also like to thank Mr. Ed Kidd, attorney and son of Margie Kidd, for all his work and time associated with the completion of this lease. 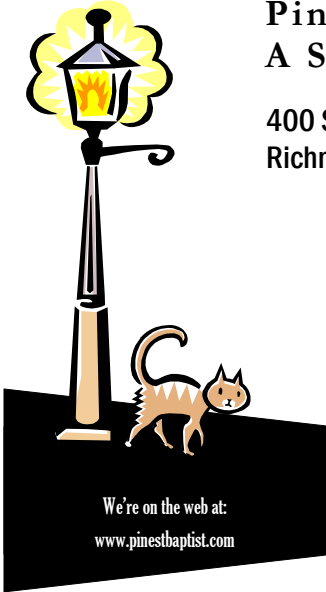
